

Minutes from meeting on August 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2018

The Millcreek Township Supervisors met at the township building at 7:00 with chairman, Ben Meckbach and supervisors Roger Bower and Russ Pidcoe all attending. Also attending were Charlie Lockard, Joe Reeder, Jerry Fisher, Linda Hopkins, Ed McHenry and Scott Oldweiler

The meeting was opened with the Pledge to the Flag.

Scott Oldweiler gave his report from the Muncy Township Fire Company and Charlie Lockard reviewed the insurance renewal. A few changes were updated. Linda Hopkins went over the flood reporting and will work it out with Swayze.

The previous minutes were approved with a motion from Ben and a second from Roger.

A sub-division for Brima Associates was reviewed with no comments to send to County.

Mail consisted of two new zoning permits and the workman comps audit report. A County officials report was updated to be sent in.

Road work was discussed and roads are almost ready for the tar and chipping. Tom is working hard on getting everything done on time and cleaning up from flood damage.

Mr. Dean from PG Energy asked about who is responsible for flood water damage. They will work it out.

A quote was received from Fisher for \$3500 to make some urgent flood damage repairs on some of the roads. Tom cannot do it all himself so Russ made a motion to accept it and Roger seconded it. Motion was carried.

A resolution to add the 2018 Impact Fee money to the budget was signed by all three supervisors with Ben moving to do so and Russ seconding it. Motion carried.

After some discussion Ben made a motion to purchase the small tractor Tom found to help out with some work for \$1800 and Roger seconded it. Motion was carried with Russ opposing.

Roger mentioned that the exhaust needs fixed on one of the trucks.

Motion was made by Russ and seconded by Roger to accept the financial statement and motion was carried and checks were signed.

Roger made a motion to adjourn at 7:45 with second from Russ.
