Flood paperwork is still being filed. No concrete information yet as to if we will get funding. Swayze will look over paperwork and fill out forms.

Marc asked about a pipe near creek he noticed. Joe will check into it.

Financial report was reviewed and motion was made by Roger and seconded by Russ to approve it. Motion was carried.
