

Minutes from the meeting on January 7, 2019

The Mill Creek Township supervisors met at the township building following the reorganizational meeting with Russ Pidcoe and Roger Bower attending. Ben Meckbach was absent. Also attending were Joe Reeder, Tom Moser, and Marc Miller.

The only public comment was Tom stating upcoming work he wanted to get done.

Motion was made by Roger and seconded by Russ to accept the previous month's minutes and motion was carried.

The mail consisted of 3 deed transfers, Klepper subdivision final paperwork, Local road safety plans from PennDot, Workmans comp and general liability policies from Lockard Insurance, and the Audit review from Penn Dot stating the only issue found was a .27 difference in ending balance due to interest which wasn't reported for December since bank statement wasn't back yet when Norma did her report that year.

Old Business: Flooding was discussed and Ben, Swayze and Tom attended the meeting last month and more papers were signed to see if we can get financial help. Ben is doing online reports. Most of the concern was the damage done by the August storm and not the July storm.

New business: A letter was received from Mc Nerney, Page, Vanderlin and Hall stating that our hourly rate was increasing to \$175. Scott Oldweiler sent in his monthly fire company report.

Roger stated that Joe Reeder has been shown the route and will be driving the CDL truck for snow plowing and cindering this winter.

Norma is trying to get more information on the low interest loan from DCED and started the application process.

Delinquent taxes in the amount of \$1513.92 were turned in for 2018 and Russ signed the forms.

Meeting was adjourned at 7:32 with motion from Roger and second from Russ.
