Public comment: Scott gave his report from the Muncy Twp. Fire Company and Wayne noted that there are several large pot holes over his way that need taken care of.

The previous month's minutes were read and approved with a motion from Ben and a second from Russ and motion was carried.

Mail: Bridge inspection report, Flood workshop meeting on Monday, and Lycoming County Sanitary Committee letter stating that we owe back pension funds for the 4 employees of \$1981.47. (Ben will have Ryan Tira look over the letter)

Vehicle purchase was again discussed. Motion was made by Russ and seconded by Ben to order the truck and then continue with applying for the PEL low interest loan. Motion was carried. Also, a motion was made by Russ and seconded by Roger to use \$25,000 out of the Impact Fee money towards the down payment. Motion was carried.

Road work was discussed and plan is to get some help filling pot holes. The supervisors will look at the roads next month and make a plan. Ben went over what he thought should be done this summer.
