

Minutes from the meeting on November 7th, 2019

The previous month's minutes were read and approved with a motion from Russ and seconded by Roger and motion was carried.

Wayne Cordrey noted that Fire Tower Road needs attention. Larry Ryder mentioned the Picture Rocks Fire Company breakfast. Scott Oldweiler gave his report from Muncy Township Fire Company.

Mail consisted of a letter stating that the Township water test was fine, real estate transfers, two codes permits and Iola breakfast invite.

Old business: Stryker couldn't bid cinders because the plant was closed and he was not sure when they would open. When open he will let us know and start delivering them. If we can't get cinders we will bid anti-skid.

Tom drove the new mower and said it should work out good for us. (somewhat hard to get in low gear)

Discussion was held on increasing the Variance fee from \$150 to \$350 for next year due to costs exceeding the fee.

Lycoming County Planning Commission subdivision for Downeys was reviewed. Norma needs to check to see if the right a way was included in the 2 acre minimum lot requirement.

The proposed budget was looked over and discussed it was approved to advertise by Russ and seconded by Roger.

The financial statement was approved with a motion from Russ and second from Roger. Motion was carried.

Meeting was adjourned at 7:40 with a motion from Ben and seconded by Russ.
